OA Unit Representative Duties

Attends unit and chapter/lodge meetings, perhaps including meetings of the unit's youth leadership (e.g., the Patrol Leaders' Council)

Links the unit to the lodge or chapter by regular, two-way communication

Coordinates the unit's OA election, as well as other unit and OA events on the unit calendar

Encourages conclave attendance, especially by new electees and Ordeal members

Promotes short- and long-term camping within the unit

Sets an excellent example for current and prospective Arrowmen

Term & Qualifications

Appointed by youth unit leader (e.g., SPL) and approved by adult leader (e.g., Scoutmaster) before typical unit-election season.

Under 18 years old for entire term

Dues-paying OA member in good standing
