Order of the Arrow Membership Requirements (abbreviated)

- Be a registered member of the BSA.
- Have experienced 15 nights of Scout camping while registered with a Troop, Crew, or Ship within the 2 years immediately prior to the election...
- Youth must be under 21, hold the Scouts BSA First Class rank, Venturing Discovery Award, or the Sea Scout Ordinary rank or higher, approved by unit leader and elected by youth members of unit.
- Adults must meet camping requirements and must be approved by the lodge adult selection committee.

Purpose of the Order of the Arrow

- Recognize those who best exemplify the Scout Oath and Law in their daily lives and through that recognition cause others to conduct themselves in a way that warrants similar recognition.
- Promote camping, responsible outdoor adventure, and environmental stewardship as essential components of every Scout's experience, in the unit, year round, and in summer camp.
- Develop leaders with the willingness, character, spirit, and ability to advance the activities of their units, our Brotherhood, Scouting, and ultimately our nation.
- Crystallize the Scout habit of helpfulness into a life purpose of leadership in cheerful service to others.



Zero Hero Award

This award is available to all registered Scouts, Venturers, Sea Scouts, and their leaders in the Voyageurs Area Council, for the purpose of promoting WINTER camping.
